What does Golden Service Extension Unit (SEU) do?

The Golden SEU provides financial assistance to individuals and families in the community who need help with rent, utilities and prescriptions. Other requests are considered if funds are available. The Unit also sponsors a Back to School Shopping Spree in August for local children needing support with clothes, backpacks and school supplies.

Who is eligible to receive assistance?

Residents with an 80401 or 80403 zip code who fall within the service area can receive assistance. Proof of residency, identification and documentation of need are required.



How does the Golden SEU raise funds?

During November and December, over 300 members of local churches, service clubs, students from Golden schools, and residents participate in the annual Bell Ringing/Kettle Campaign. Donations received at several sites throughout the community determine the budget for the upcoming year. Of the funds raised, 90% stays in Golden and a 10% tithe is sent to The Salvation Army Intermountain Division.

Individuals and various organizations also make financial contributions during the year.

When was the Golden Service Extension Unit established?

The Golden community organized a local Service Extension Unit in the fall of 2002. Current members of the Golden SEU Committee include residents and representatives from local churches and organizations, including Calvary Episcopal, Faith Lutheran, First Baptist, First United Methodist, First Presbyterian, St. Joseph Catholic, Hillside Community, Golden Kiwanis Club and Golden Lions Club.
